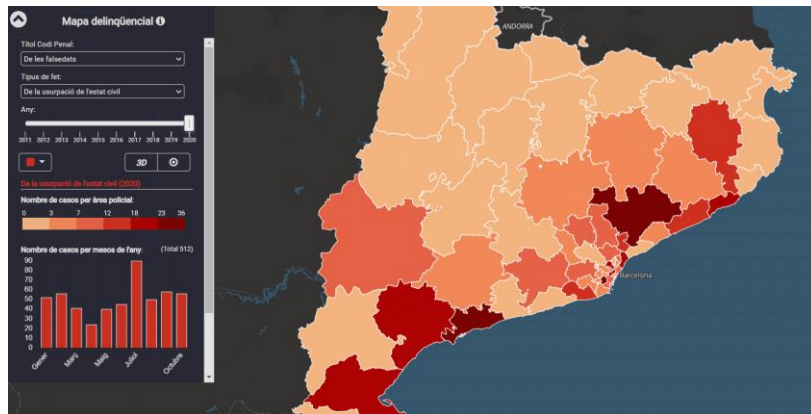


Description

Mapa delinqüencial is a website showing criminal data on a map. Specifically, the number of cases categorised by the type of offense, per year (2011- 2020) in various regions within Catalonia. It is designed to monitor delinquency in order to deploy police enforcement in the regions where crime is highest, but also to make this type of information more visible to citizens generally.

Benefits

- Citizens are provided with accurate information about the prevalence of crime in their area
- Police can monitor crime rates per region and use this as the basis for choices regarding their enforcement approaches



How open data is used

Crime figures are put forward by the police departments of Catalonia, and are freely available to the public. This data is visualised on a map designed by the Catalan Cartographic and Geologic Institution. The code underlying this map is available on GitHub, the open-source platform.
