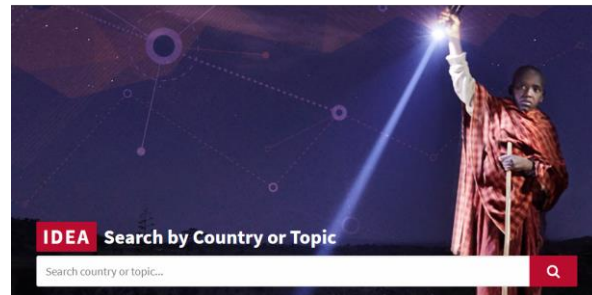


Description

The International Data & Economic Analysis (IDEA) is an online database providing access to country-level data across the globe. Created by the United States Agency for International Development (USAID) and initially set up to support the staff and associates of USAID find data from external sources, the IDEA database now provides access to over 10 000 data series and is categorised along the themes: people government, official development assistance, economy, education, and health.

Benefits

The IDEA database makes it possible to analyse data with an online query tool, a country dashboard, or through various visualisations such as factsheets of historical economic and demographic trends; and country-level indicators, e.g. national income per capita.



How open data is used

The data available on IDEA consists of third party data that is publicly available or provided with a Creative Commons Attribution-No Derivatives 4.0 license or a Government Work License, i.e. free of copyright.
